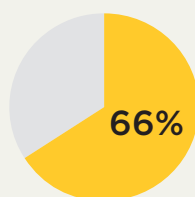
Experiences in School

1.4M adults in the U.S. are transgender, including **218,000** current students

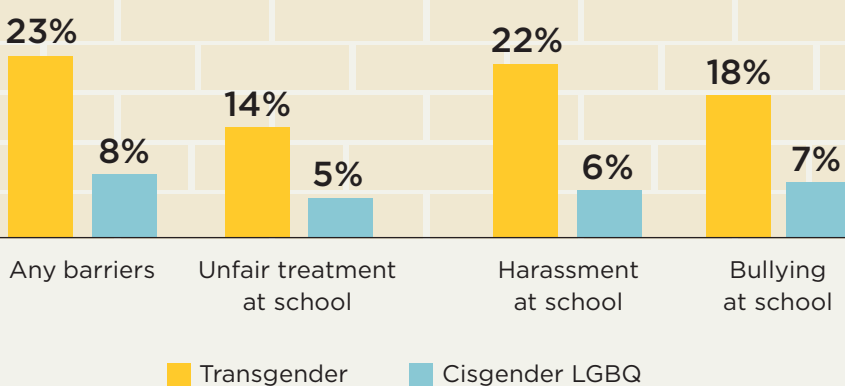


Over **40%** of transgender adults report not fully belonging at school because they are LGBTQ.

Two thirds of transgender adults reported having to hide their gender identity at school.

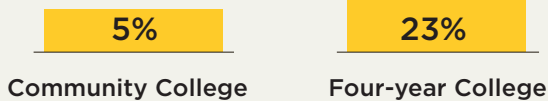


Nearly one in four transgender adults reported barriers to achieving their educational goals.

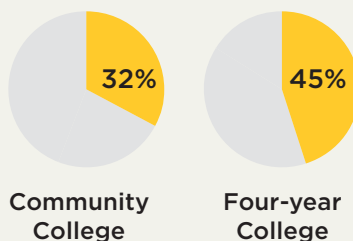


Transgender-Inclusive School Policies

Few transgender college students reported that their school allowed gender changes on records and documents.



Less than half of transgender people said their school had gender-neutral bathrooms.



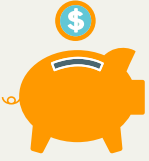
Only 1/3 of transgender people who attended a four-year college said their school offered gender-inclusive housing.

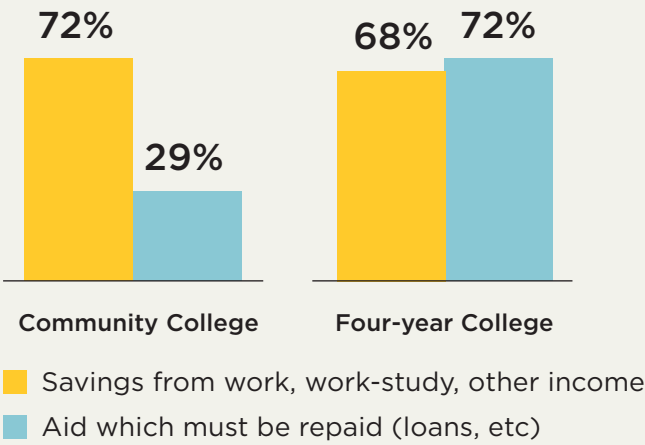
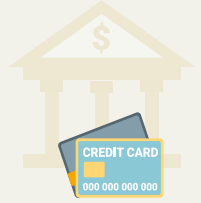
